Steps the LWDB, Chief Elected Official (CEO), and ARIZONA@WORK Job Center partners took to reach consensus and/or an assurance that the Local Workforce Development Area followed guidance for the state infrastructure funding mechanism

The co-located partners have decided to use the Occupancy basis for Facility costs, FTE for additional costs.

The process ARIZONA@WORK Job Center partners will use to resolve issues related to infrastructure funding during the MOU duration period when consensus cannot be reached

Partners will meet with the LWDB to negotiate a resolution to resolve issues related to infrastructure funding. If a resolution cannot be reached the LWDB and ARIZONA@WORK Job Center partners will seek technical assistance from the State of Arizona to reach a consensus.

A description of the periodic modification and review process to ensure equitable benefit among ARIZONA@WORK Job Center partners

All partner contributions, regardless of the source, will be reconciled and adjusted accordingly on a quarterly basis to ensure each partner program is contributing no more than its proportionate share based upon relative benefits received in accordance with the Uniformed Guidance at 2 CFR part 200. Budgeted contributions will be validated against actual expenditures and adjusted on a quarterly cadence. Then, the reconciliation will be shared with partner programs contacts listed in this agreement.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this addendum is to define parameters whereby the workforce core partners create seamless, customer-focused ARIZONA@WORK-Southeastern Arizona system that aligns service delivery and enhances access to program services. Specifically, this document will outline the "other shared costs" section located in the Infrastructure Funding Agreement (IFA) as it relates to the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act(WIOA) 107(d) and 20 CFR 679.370 of the Southeastern Arizona Memorandum of Understanding. This addendum clarifies the parameters in which Title IB staff may receive funds from Title II to provide additional benefits and services to co-enrolled participants between Title 1-B and Title II.

INTENT

The intent of this addendum is to support the ARIZONA@WORK system and to begin the process of tracking and enrolling additional clients/students in core partner programs. This addendum will help develop baseline data on the number of individuals co-registered/co-enrolled across the system and will allow each core partner to track individuals who receive services. All partners noted in the addendum agree that there is a need to collaborate and share data in order to provide benefit to Title II students and Title I-B participants. This addendum represents a first step in realizing the larger vision of the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA). Partners

in this addendum understand that any progress made toward tracking and co-enrolling participants is considered a success.

OVERVIEW

Arizona Department of Education subcontractor, Cochise College Adult Education (CCAE), serves approximately 400 students each fiscal year with the capacity to enroll additional students. In each fiscal year of this agreement, the Arizona Department of Education will provide workforce set-aside funds to CCAE. These funds are exclusively designated for shared system costs to support the ARIZONA@WORK system, which is aligned to the Southeastern Arizona (SEAZ) MOU referenced above. These funds will be used to support collaboration between Title 1B and Title II core partner programs to increase the number of co-enrolled students/clients who successfully access the workforce system.

OBJECTIVE

To support Title II students who need career and employment services by increasing the number of co-registered and co-enrolled students/clients. Co-enrollment will directly benefit client's employment and educational outcomes.

SHARED RESPONSIBILTIES

CCAE will provide an equitable portion of its shared adult education work force system funding to the SEAZ ARIZONA@WORK Adult. Dislocated Worker, and Youth Programs (Title IB) to support any costs associated with activities designed to increase the number of clients coregistered/co-enrolled and actively using services within the workforce system. Both Title IB and Title II partners will respect the individual choice of customers and clients seeking assistance.

LSERVICES PROVIDED

A. TITLE 1-B VISITS to TITLE II LOCATIONS

Up to 25% of the total funds is allocated to support costs incurred by Title 1B staff to conduct visits to Title II adult education locations. CCAE will provide Title IB staff space to visit four (4) CCAE locations throughout Southeastern Arizona. Visits to CCAE locations will take place a minimum of 20 times per year to provide information sessions about workforce opportunities available at ARIZONA@WORK facilities and to potentially complete Arizona Job Connection (AJC) Plus account. Title 1B staff must consult with the Title II Director to collaborate on specific dates to leverage existing resources and to maximize effectiveness. Successful visits are defined as a minimum of three (3) hours per visit, which must include mornings and evenings (i.e. when students attend adult education classes) completed by the Title IB representative. Title 1B staff will present CCAE participants in their regular classroom setting. After presentations, private space will be designated for Title IB staff to meet individually with participants who request additional information, desire to register/enroll in a program or wish to schedule a follow-up appointment. Once agreed upon, the visits will take place according to the following schedule:

 Sierra Vista location- (2) visits per quarter, (8) total visits (August, September, October, November, February, March, April, May)

- Douglas location (1) visit per quarter. (4) total visits (September, November, February, April)
- Benson location-(1) visit per quarter, (4) total visits (September, November, February, April)
- Wilcox location-(1) visit perquarter, (4) total visits (September, November, February, April)

B. TITLE II REFERRALS to Title 1-B

Up to 60% of the total adult education system funds will be disbursed to Title IB for successful co-registrations, co-enrollments, and Title IB program completions. A successful co-registration is defined as the creation of an "AJC Plus account." A successful co-enrollment is defined as enrollment in either an Individualized Adult/Dislocated Worker or a Youth program according to customer choice. A successful program completion is defined as one that culminates in certification. If certification is unavailable, the participant must adequately satisfy all program requirements (hours, assessments, etc.), as verified by Title IB staff.

In fiscal year 2023, CCAE registered, enrolled and provided instruction to a total of 490 students (i.e. individuals who were eligible and accrued 12 or more hours of attendance, as defined by OCTAE and the Arizona Department of Education). To remain consistent with the other active Title II-Title IB- MOU/IFA agreements throughout Arizona, CCAE suggests Southeastern Arizona Title IB staff engage with 20% of their population (equal to 98 students).

- 1/3 of the 60% allocation will be provided to Title 1B for the successful coregistration of 98 Title 11 students in AJC-Plus throughout FY23.
- 1/3 of the 60% allocation will be provided to Title IB for the successful coenrollment in a Title IB training/career services program throughout FY23 at a rate of \(\frac{1}{2} \) of the total number of registered students (equal to 49 students)
- 1/3 of the 60% allocation will be provided to Title IB for successful participant completion of formal Title IB individualized training programs at a rate of % of the total registration (equal 10 students) throughout FY23.

C. TITLE IB REFERRALS TO TITLE II

In order to promote enrollment growth and better serve the SEAZ workforce area, the remaining 15% of the adult workforce system funds will be allocated based on successful referrals by Title IB for co-enrollment in the Title II adult education program. All individuals who lack basic skills or are English language learners will receive priority of service. The last 15% allocation will be disbursed if a minimum of 49 clients (10%) of the FY23 student enrollment), aged 16 years and older and not in a K-12 educational program or required to be in one, are referred during the current fiscal year. Successful enrollment in a Title II adult education program is defined as documentation of a student "registration date" in the Arizona Adult Education Data Management System (AAEDMS) and a minimum of one documented class attendance session.

D. DISBURSEMENT & TRACKING

a. All visits, registrations and enrollments will be tracked quarterly, and funds will be disbursed prior to the last day of the month immediately following the measurement quarter.

- **b.** Funds will be prorated if the five (5) outlined metrics (e.g. visits, co-registrants, co-enrollees, completions, Title II referrals) are not fully met. The metrics outlined in this agreement are based on a full year (i.e. July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024). As such, if the addendum becomes effective "mid- year", then the metrics are reduced to account for the shortened term. However, Title IB program manager may engage in accelerated activities to meet the full-year metrics in the shortened timeframe. The full funding amount is available for disbursement through June 30, 2024.
- **c.** Funds will be distributed quarterly through the Title 11-CCAE Business/Accounting office.
- **d.** The Title II Program Director, or designee, at CCAE and the Title 1B Program Manager, or designee, will manage and monitor the shared responsibilities between Title 1B and Title II Workforce System Partners.
- e. The Title 1B representative will keep a log of each visit by meeting date, time, duration, and location to facilitate the tracking of Title 11 location visits.
- f. To facilitate tracking of co-registrations, co-enrollments and completions, the Title II Program Director, or designee, will provide a spreadsheet of Title II students (including Last Name, First Name, Date of Birth, and AAEDMS Registration Date) to the Title IB Program Manager (or designee) on a monthly basis via a password protected google drive. Matching student records from the Title IB partner, including the date registered in the AJC system, the date enrolled in one or more programs, the program name, and program completion, will then be shared back to the Title II Program Director, or designee.

*Note-Until AJC access for local staff is modified, student/participant tracking must run through state-level DES staff,

- g. Pre-existing co-registrants/co-enrollments (i.e. those that exist prior to the date of execution of this agreement) are not included in this agreement and therefor no funds will be provided for these participants.
- h. The Title II Program Director, or designee, at CCAE and the Title IB Program Manager, ordesignee, will report data monthly to the Arizona Department of Education-Adult Education Services and staff, which will then distribute the information to the Southeastern Arizona Workforce Development Board on a quarterly basis at the Board meetings. This addendum helps local workforce board fulfill their responsibilities of leading efforts in the local area to identify and promote proven and promising strategies, program oversight including appropriate use, management and investment of funds, and coordination with education providers.

E. TERM

This addendum becomes effective once the addendum is signed by the partners and approved by the SEAZ workforce development board and will last through the fiscal year-ending date of June 30, 2024, with potential of renewal if Title II funding allocations remain consistent and neither Title IB nor Title II partners request changes to this agreement. Renewal will begin on July I, 2023. The FY 2023 metrics will be based on the FY 2023 Title II enrollment data which may differ from previous term of agreement. As funding is tied to Title II enrollment, the funding amount may also increase.

F. NOTICES

All matters relating to the administration and performance of this addendum shall be referred to the Partner's representative or any other person designated by such Partner for such purpose. All partners agree to notify one another in writing within (10) days of any change in that Partner's Program contact information.
